A note from the Executive Director:

We are off and running in 2025! The Board of Directors of Women's Care Center met for the annual planning and training meeting in early January. The board approved the expansion of our services to a Mobile Medical unit which will be purchased by March, 2025. The build time for these units is 8-10 months so it will be late 2025 or early 2026 before we are fully operational. Thanks to a very generous growth donation in the fall, the fundraising that remains is for the ongoing operational costs.

Imagine the additional women we will be able to reach if we go out into our surrounding counties and college communities to provide pregnancy testing and ultrasounds. As we begin to develop a regular schedule to these areas, we will see the traffic increase. This mobile unit will not see the same volume of clients as our Dudley location but if we reach just one more!

Our second area of news is that we will be joining Heartbeat International's Abortion Pill Rescue Network. Please take a minute and read about this lifesaving protocol that has a 63%-68% success rate of saving babies. Women who have changed their minds after taking the first abortion pill but before they take the second, will find hope! You can read about this at abortionpillreversal.com. We will be sharing more about both of these areas of growth at the banquet and in future communications.

We are blessed to live in a state that protects life but we are surrounded by states who do not. Our patients have access to abortion pills through the mail and facilities within a short driving distance. Now is the time to be bold & courageous. We will lean into the promise of God in Joshua 1:9 through His Holy Spirit who moves and works through our staff and volunteers.





We have been busy the last few months of 2024. We have had several new employees join our team, praise the Lord! This growth has made us get creative with our current office space. We turned each office into two and thankfully have been able to provide a workstation for all employees. But most importantly, we have seen an increase in our services to the women in our community. We hope to be able to offer even more appointment times once our new staff is fully trained.



We are also excited to announce that we have started providing same day test results for sexually transmitted infections. Currently, we test for Chlamydia, Gonorrhea and Trichomoniasis using a PCR test that provides test results in 30 minutes. Previously our patients would have to wait a few days for results and treatment. Now, we are able to provide same day testing and treatment if needed. We are working on policies and procedures so we can include testing for HIV, Syphilis and Hepatitis.


