I am in awe of all that God has done to establish Women's Care Center as the only pregnancy help AAAHC accredited medical clinic in WV. God used Janet Kimes, the board, and so many qualified members of the staff over the years in a mighty way to establish a strong, vibrant ministry. It is my fervent prayer and mission to honor God and all that Janet, and the Board of Directors has built here in Parkersburg. While at the same time, listening to how God would have us grow and respond to the ever-changing landscape of the options women face today. Never compromising on our mission, goals, and God's truth!

Wow, what a busy summer this has been for us here at Women's Care Center. In the months of June and July we have seen a total of 127 unique patients with a total of 176 visits and we still have one more month of summer left! In the previous three months we saw a total of 169 unique patients for 272 total visits. Currently projected numbers have us on track to have a 22% increase in volume of patients served just this summer alone! What amazing work the staff and volunteers of Women's Care Center are doing for God and these patients in our community. Reaching out, connecting to people, and saving the lives of unborn babies. Praise the Lord and Thank you for everything you are doing to help Women's Care Center in whatever capacity whether it be on staff, volunteering, serving on the board, giving monetarily, helping with fundraising, or being a prayer warrior, I am truly thankful to all of you! I am definitely blessed to be serving in the role as Nurse Manager and coming to work every day witnessing the power of Jesus working in the clinic and in the lives of our patients.
